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## FILM LOCATIONS ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF TOWN

**10. Frohnburg Palace:** Maria sings *I Have Confidence* on the way to her new job yet seems intimidated when she sees the villa for the first time.

**11. Hellbrunn:** this is the site of the glass pavilion where both couples Liesl and Rolf with *Sixteen going on Seventeen* and Maria and the Baron with *Something Good* declare their love for each other.

**12. Leopoldskron Castle:** Maria and the children capsize while mooring the rowing boat. Maria and the Baron, already head over heels in love with each other, have an argument here.  
*The area is not open to the public!*



## FILM LOCATIONS OUTSIDE TOWN

You can easily reach the film locations outside town by public transport or car.

**13. Untersberg:** *The Sound of Music* plays in the opening scene with the towering mountain sides of the Untersberg and *Climb Every Mountain* when the family sets out to escape there.

Bus 25 or 5 from Salzburg main station or Mirabellplatz to the Untersberg cable car, which leads to the summit.

**14. Mondsee Basilica:** Maria and Georg von Trapp step before the altar to the sound the sounds of the church organ to exchange their wedding vows. Bus 140 from Salzburg main station or Mirabellplatz to Mondsee.

**15. St. Gilgen:** this idyllic village at the Wolfgangsee lake is shown from a bird's eye view. During the title sequence of *The Sound of Music*. The melody of *My Favorite Things* plays as Maria and the children take the Schafberg railway up the mountain for a picnic.

Bus 150 from Salzburg main station or Mirabellplatz to St. Gilgen.



## SOUND OF MUSIC – TOURS

**Bus tour:** with a guide and background music, the 4 hour tour takes you to the main film locations in the town of Salzburg, St. Gilgen and Mondsee.

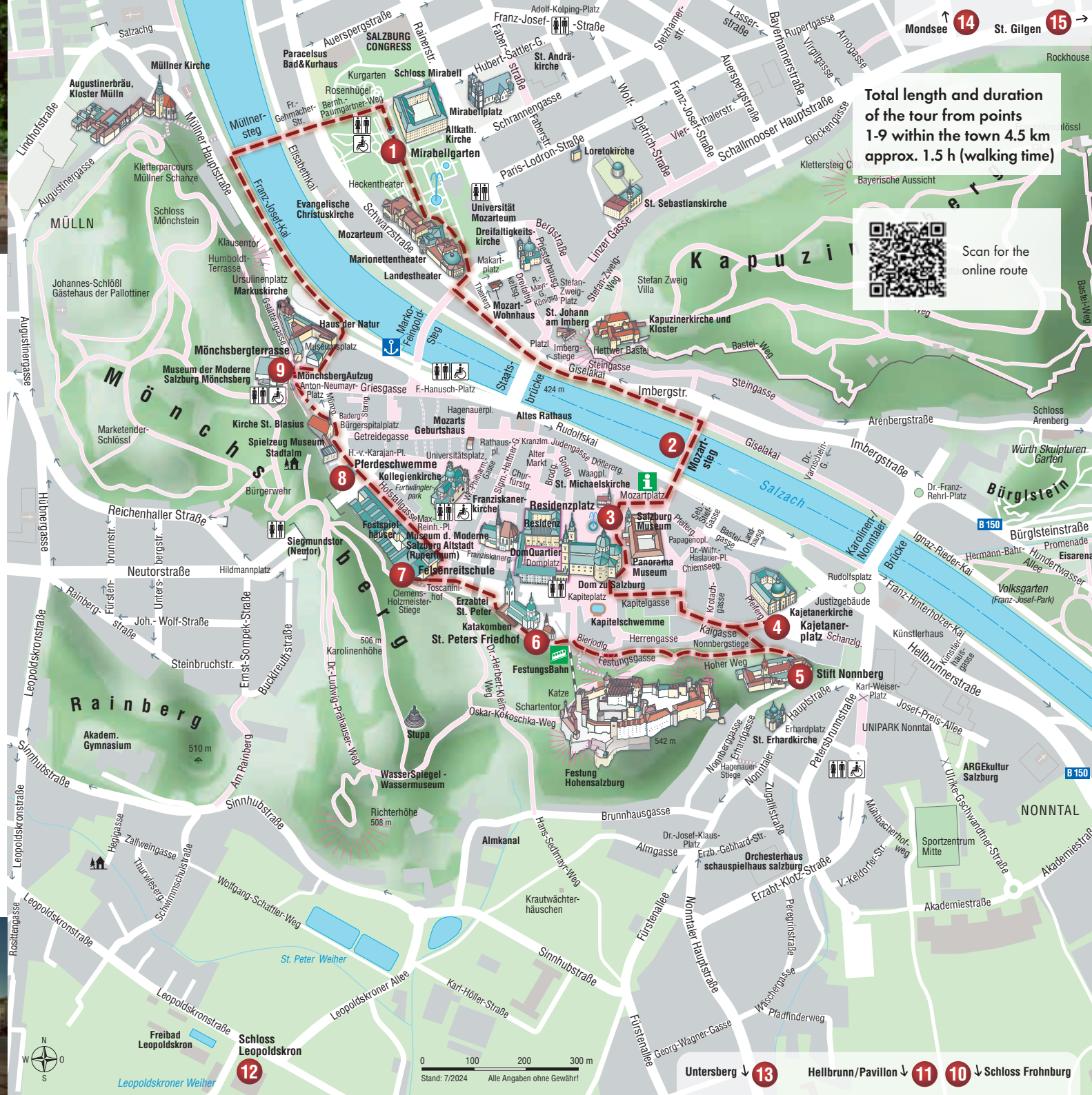


## A HOLLYWOOD TALE INSPIRED BY REAL LIFE

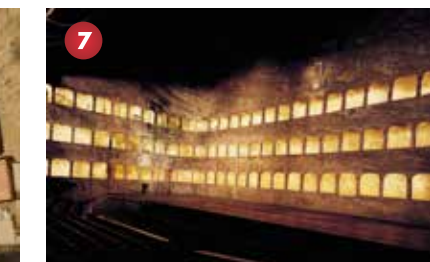
When the young Maria Kutschera took up her new position as governess to the seven children of wealthy widower Georg von Trapp in 1926, married him just one year later, founded a family choir that would touch hearts around the world and finally emigrated to America, she certainly never dared to dream that Hollywood would make her story famous around the globe. Hollywood embellished the biographical facts with a dramatic escape, timeless melodies and impressive landscape shots, making **The Sound of Music** one of the most successful films of all time. Follow in the footsteps of The Sound of Music with us and visit the original film locations in and around Salzburg.

## FILM LOCATIONS IN THE TOWN OF SALZBURG

- Mirabell Gardens:** Maria and the children sing *Do-Re-Mi* while dancing through the Mirabell Gardens, the Heckentheater [hedge theatre] and the fountains up to the marble stairs leading to the Rosenhügel [rose hill].
- Mozartsteg:** Maria and the children cross over the Mozartsteg while singing *My Favorite Things*.
- Residenzplatz:** on her way to her new employer, Maria passes the Residenz fountain and sings *I Have Confidence*.



- Kajetanerplatz:** while Maria and the children shop at the farmers' market, *My Favorite Things* can be heard in the background.
- Nonnberg Convent:** here the nuns sing *Maria*, and the abbess warns Maria with *Climb Every Mountain*, to make this right decision. The children come looking for Maria, and in the escape scene the nuns hide the von Trapp family from the Nazis.
- St. Peter's cemetery:** the parents and the children hide in the crypt arcades below the catacombs.



- Felsenreitschule [summer riding school]:** here, the family choir performs *Do-Re-Mi*, *Edelweiss* and *So Long, Farewell* at a singing competition, before fleeing from the Nazis. *The interior can be visited only within a tour of the Festival Hall.*
- Pferdeschwemme [horse fountain]:** on an outing in town Maria and the children pass the horse fountain with the melody of *My Favorite Things* playing in the background.
- Mönchsberg Terrace:** here, Maria and the children sing *Do-Re-Mi* with the fortress in the background.
